

Worksheet to Calculate UC GPA

Directions

1. Obtain a copy of your transcript
2. Exclude courses taken in the 9th grade
3. Consider summer before 10th and 11th grades; consider intersession in grades 10th , 11th and Fall of 12th
4. Exclude non "a-g" courses such as PE, student aid, ROP, computer, etc.
5. Review Repeat courses:
 - a. If the same identical course is repeated and first grade is a D or F; exclude first grade
 - b. If the same identical course is repeated and first grade is a C; first grade is kept and second attempt not considered
 - c. If the course is repeated, but different levels such as Honors/AP/IB retaken in summer at the regular level include both grades
6. Review Honor/AP/IB courses earned with grades "C" or better (each semester earns 1 point) - Maximum allowed is 8
 - a. For 10th grade award up to 4 points only (student may earned more, but only 2 are allowed)
 - b. For 11th grade award up to 4 points only if student earned 2 during 10th grade
 - c. For 11th grade award up to 8 points if student did not earn any points during 10th grade
